In advance of the Christmas break, we are providing you with an update on plans and next steps in the Stephenville High and Piccadilly Central High school system review process.

In the interest of having an informed community discussion around the Motion, a new and updated web page for this phase of the review process is being compiled and will be shared with your school community early in the new year.

Also expected in January, school community members will have an opportunity to provide feedback to the Newfoundland and Labrador English School Board Trustees on the specific Motion outlined at their December 7, 2019 public meeting and provided to you earlier this month. Another opportunity to provide online feedback will be made available through our community consultation tool, ThoughtExchange, and a public school community meeting is anticipated to be scheduled for **February/early-March** in your area. We anticipate being back to you in early-January with an updated web page and more established dates around these consultations.
