

# *Fangs and Me* Reader Response Assignment: Board Game

You have been hired by Scholastic Canada to create a board game to help students review the novel *Fangs and Me*.

You must include elements from each chapter of the novel, character information, plot, setting and theme in your work. Be creative!

Your board game should include:

- A bristol board background (decorate it to represent the novel)
- Two sets of game cards
  - Questions to answer about the story
  - Chance cards that have good and bad parts (ex: Buddy pushes you off a swing, go back three spaces OR Fangs eats a big moth: take another turn, etc.)
- Game pieces
- Dice or a spinner (or both)
- Game spaces for the pieces to travel on. Have fun with these!
- A set of instructions explaining how to play the game.

Steps for making your game board:

1. Your group should make a plan for how you want your game board to look (use blank white paper to sketch a design)
2. Develop a set of rules for your game. Make sure to include everything players need to know (number of players needed, how to use the game cards, how to win, etc.). See Example rules sheet for a sample of how some games make their rules.
3. Write draft content for your question cards and your chance cards using your notes from the novel study. There should be at least 10 of each
4. Make the game board and pieces (you must meet with Mr. Ivany to discuss your work BEFORE you create your final draft of the game).
